#### **2023 Annual Meeting**

The 2023 annual meeting was held November 16, 2023 at the Pease Public Library in Plymouth, both in-person and virtually. The NHMF Board of Directors officially welcomed nine new members - five musicians and four community members. Voting members of the New Hampshire Music Festival are those who donate \$100+ during the previous calendar year.

### **Classics Series**

As we reflect on the past season, our Classics Series programming focused on the theme of "Connections," highlighting the interplay between different musical traditions, historical periods, and cultural influences. Beyond musical connections, we also highlighted the connection with our communities in central New Hampshire - performing orchestral programs in Plymouth, Gilford, and Lebanon. Our goal was to deepen our relationships with our audiences both from the concert hall stage and through conversations in the lobby.

We were thrilled to welcome back Paul Polivnick, Conductor Laureate, whose handling of classics, new music, romantic powerhouses, and nostalgic Americana revealed the colors and drama of the music in tandem with the incredible talents of our Festival musicians. We presented three excellent soloists, each of whom added a special touch to the performance - NHMF's Principal Oboist Shawn Welk, trumpeter Susan Rider, and Plymouth-native mezzo soprano Claire McCahan.

### **Chamber Music Series**

The Chamber Music series was held in Smith Recital Hall at the Plymouth State University Silver Center, and was a resounding success. Music curated, prepared, and performed by musicians of the New Hampshire Music Festival took our audiences on a journey of the classical chamber music repertoire from 1720 to 2002 covering the music of Vivaldi, Beethoven, Brahms, Britton, Piazzolla and many others.

### **Music in the Mountains**

This year's Music in the Mountains series offered performances in diverse locations - Plymouth's Cafe Monte Alto and Gazebo on the Common, Waterville Valley's nature trail and Garden Gazebo at the Rey Cultural Center, Laconia's Taylor Community, and on top of West Rattlesnake Mountain in Holderness. These free community events offered patrons the chance to hear many small ensembles flutes, harp, violins, cellos, and more! These performances were listened to by approximately 335 people, ranging in age from 2 years to 90 years.
